Policy for Holiday Decoration & Lighting

Approved by the Board of Directors October 17, 2023, as authorized by Covenant Article 14.05 "Additional Rules"

All outdoor holiday decorations & lighting must be appropriate to the specific holiday and may be put up four (4) weeks prior to the holiday and must be removed seven (7) days after the holiday.

The board agreed to the following exceptions:

- Halloween decorations & lighting may be erected mid-September and must be removed seven (7) days after the holiday.
- Christmas/Hanukkah/Yule/Kwanzaa/Omisoka decorations & lighting may be put up as early as mid-November and may remain until January 31st. (If using a professional company to install lighting it can be installed as early as the last week of October but is not to be turned on until mid-November, and will still need to be removed in a timely manner).
- Holiday decorations must reflect the event for which they are being presented.
 - i.e. Halloween decorations would not be suitable for Thanksgiving, Christmas, or Valentine's day, etc.
- Exterior lighting shall be from white sources only, (no colored lights) except for the temporary, decorative lighting for holidays, as referenced in Covenant 10.14.
